MODEL AGREEMENT ART BRA® AUSTIN 2017

As with any volunteer activity, serving as a model requires commitments of both time and enthusiasm for the mission of BCRC and the fundraising event. The expectations associated with being an Art Bra Austin Model are listed below. A digital version of the Model Agreement is included in the online model application (available at www.artbraaustin.org); we request all models read and consent to each statement of the agreement before submitting their application. We also suggest all models print this agreement to keep for their records.

1. The call for Art Bra Austin Models is open to all clients of BCRC. Art Bra Austin Models are encouraged to serve a two-year term.
2. Clients who have served two or more years as an Art Bra Austin Model and would like to model again may initially be placed on a waiting list to ensure new models have the chance to participate.
3. Art Bra Models make up a collective group that reflect the diversity of BCRC clients. As such, we expect all Art Bra Models to treat one another with mutual respect regardless of age, race, color, religion, political belief, national origin, disability, or sexual orientation. If differences persist between Art Bra Models or Art Bra Volunteers, they should be discussed directly with the Development Director.
4. It is BCRC policy that any event hosted by the organization maintains a civil and congenial environment, free from all forms of discrimination, harassment, and violence. Anyone engaging in harassing conduct will be subject to discipline, ranging from a warning to termination from the Art Bra Model roster.
5. Art Bra Austin Models are ambassadors of BCRC and Art Bra Austin and encouraged to promote event attendance and participate in appropriate publicity opportunities, including media outreach.
6. Serving as an Art Bra Model can be physically taxing. Please place the utmost importance on your health and well-being. BCRC clients who are within five years of treatment or are currently in treatment (defined as chemotherapy, radiation, surgery) will be required to submit a signed release from your doctor indicating the level at which it is safe for you to participate. However, BCRC CPNs

reserve the right to make decisions on behalf of clients based on their assessment the day of event.

7. Models must attend the event on Saturday, June 3, 2017 at the Austin Convention Center, and are required to attend at least two of the following required pre-show model events:
 - a. Model Fitting – March 18, 2017
 - b. Model School – April 1, 2017
 - c. Costume Clinics – April 15/19/20, 2017 (attend 1 of the 3-day options)
8. For your safety, Runway/Floor Models are strongly discouraged from consuming alcohol prior to/during the show. No outside alcohol is permitted inside the venue.
9. Models will be assigned an art bra on the basis of a variety of criteria including but not limited to size, coverage, aesthetics, etc. Although a model's preference for a particular bra will be taken into consideration, we request that all models display a commitment to the best possible showing of the Art Bra collection as a whole.
10. Art Bra Models are asked to provide the costume and accessories to complete their runway or floor model look based on the art bra assigned to them. Please note there is typically a cost associated with costuming, such as costume rental fees and/or purchasing jewelry and accessories. If this poses a serious financial burden on you, please advise a BCRC staff member or the Model Subcommittee Chair, and we will do our best to assist you with the costuming costs.
11. Art Bra Austin is a professionally choreographed runway and floor show. While Art Bra Models have some discretion in determining costuming, BCRC staff reserves the right to oversee costuming choices in order to ensure the integrity of the overall show. Every attempt will be made to ensure Models look and feel comfortable and beautiful in their costume.
12. All Art Bra Models are required to secure a sponsorship, buy/sell at least 2 reserved-level tickets to Art Bra Austin, or obtain at least \$250 in donations through an online personal fundraising page. You will be assisted in the creation of this page. BCRC will also provide training and ongoing support to ensure your personal fundraising success.

Ultimately, this is NOT a binding contract, but compliance with the Art Bra Austin Model Agreement is paramount to ensuring the success of Art Bra Austin and its related promotional events. Art Bra Models are a central feature of the event and we hope this commitment is entered into with sincerity.
